NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and/or act on the following matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the October 2, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial investment reports, authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Review activity reports and/or receive updates regarding Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office;
7. Engineering Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
 - (i) Installation of permanent emergency generator at the District's remote water well (McDonald Municipal and Industrial);
 - c. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
 - d. Status of repair of a portion of SOX erosion repair system located at Little Prong Creek by Double Oak Erosion;
 - e. Status of condition assessment of Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1;
 - f. Discussion regarding required update to Flood Damage Prevention Regulations; and
 - g. Updated Capital Improvement Plan
8. Report by Champions, regarding maintenance of drainage facilities;
9. Status of renewal of the TPDES Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and updated Storm Water Management Plan ("SWMP");
10. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;

 - k. Water Wise Fest held on November 3, 2024, in cooperation with surrounding municipal utility districts;

 15. Convene in Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, for consultation with the District's attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege;
 16. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from discussions in Closed Session; and
 17. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
